

**Information Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the General Data Protection Regulation - Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter also GDPR)**

1. DATA CONTROLLER

The Data Controller is UniCredit Foundation ETS, with registered office in Milan, Piazza Gae Aulenti 3, Tower A, 20154 Milan.

2. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF PROCESSING

**UniCredit Foundation ETS**, as the promoter of the "Edu-fund Platform" call for proposals (the "**Call**"), as well as the data controller of the personal data of the participants collected in connection with their participation in the aforementioned Call, as regulated by the relevant regulations available at: <https://edufundplatform.apply-idea360.com/> (the "**Regulation**"), processes your personal data:

a. to enable your participation in the Call, and to ensure the correct and regular execution of what is provided for in the Regulation. Registration on the website <https://edufundplatform.apply-idea360.com/> (the "Website") or login to the same, in case of already registered user, is a condition for participation in the Call. The applicable legal basis in this case is that referred to in Article 6 (1), letter b) of the GDPR (i.e., processing necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are a party). These requirements constitute the legal basis that legitimizes the consequent processing. The provision of data necessary for these purposes is a requirement for participation in the Call and, therefore, failure to provide them to UniCredit Foundation ETS will result in the impossibility of participating in the Call and being awarded the prizes provided for in the Regulation governing it;

b. to fulfill the administrative, accounting, and fiscal purposes of the Regulation, as well as legal obligations and/or requests from the Public Authority. The applicable legal basis in this case is that referred to in Article 6 (1) letter c) of the GDPR (processing necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the data controller is subject). These requirements constitute the legal basis that legitimizes the consequent processing. The provision of data necessary for these purposes is a legal obligation and, therefore, failure to provide them to UniCredit Foundation ETS may result in the impossibility of fulfilling the related obligations.

3. CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA

Within the scope of the aforementioned purposes, the Data Controller may collect the following categories of personal data including, but not limited to, personal data (name, surname, tax code) and contact details (telephone number, *email* address, postal address).

4. RECIPIENTS OR CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

The following may become aware of your personal data as Data Processors: individuals and legal entities providing certain services in favor of UniCredit Foundation and, as persons authorized to process personal data, with respect to data necessary for the performance of their assigned duties, individuals belonging to the following categories: UniCredit employees or secondees, temporary workers, interns, consultants, and employees of external companies appointed as Data Processors.

5. TRANSFER OF DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES

UniCredit Foundation informs you that your personal data will not be transferred to countries outside the European Union or the European Economic Area (so-called Third Countries).

6. PROCESSING METHODS

The processing of personal data is carried out using manual, IT, and telematic tools with logic strictly related to the purposes themselves and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

7. DATA SUBJECTS' RIGHTS

The GDPR grants you the right to **know** what data concerning you is in the possession of UniCredit Foundation, as well as how it is used, and to obtain, where applicable, a copy, deletion, updating, rectification or, if there is an interest, integration of the data as well as the right to portability. Additionally, you may revoke consent to the processing of your personal data at any time.

#### 8. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The Data Controller will retain your personal data for the entire duration of your participation in the Call and for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected, or alternatively for the time required by applicable laws or regulatory requirements. At the end of the applicable retention period, personal data relating to you will be deleted or stored in a form that does not allow your identification (e.g., irreversible anonymization), unless further processing is necessary for one or more of the following purposes: i) resolution of pre-litigation and/or litigation initiated before the end of the retention period; ii) to follow up on investigations/inspections by internal control functions and/or external authorities initiated before the end of the retention period; iii) to follow up on requests from the Italian and/or foreign public authority received/notified to the Data Controller before the end of the retention period.

#### 9. EXERCISING RIGHTS

The response period is **one (1) month**, extendable by **two (2) months** in cases of particular complexity; in such cases, UniCredit Foundation will provide at least one interim communication within **one (1) month**. The exercise of rights is, in principle, free of charge.

#### 10. COMPLAINT OR REPORT TO THE DATA PROTECTION AUTHORITY

UniCredit Foundation informs you that you have the right to lodge a complaint or make a report to *the Data Protection Authority*, or alternatively to take legal action. The contact details of the *Data Protection Authority* can be found on the website <http://www.garanteprivacy.it>.
